FSDr = Fachschaft Doktorat


University Representation

- Period of office: two years
- Next election: May 2025

- Works council (for scientific staff) election¹
 - Period of office: four years
 - Next election: November 2024
- Faculty council election²
 - Period of office: four years
 - Next election: November 2023
- Senate election³
 - Period of office: three years
 - Next election: May 2025

The doctoral programs are based on the curriculum¹.


- Scope and duration: in total 180 ECTS; is aimed at a duration² of three years.
- Program structure:
 - Curricular part³: 18 ECTS of courses
 - Research, writing of the thesis and defence (Rigorosum):
 162 ECTS

Curricular Part - and other Courses

Courses for the doctoral program:

- Courses from universities https://fsdr.at/index.php/required-coursework/
- Courses from the Department for HR Development and Health (e.g. WINA+), do not count for curricular part
- Any other courses useful for your doctorate
- Ultimate decision is with your dean of studies

Agreement with Supervisor - Examples

- Doctoral Program:
 - Thesis topic
 - Research infrastructure
 - Courses for the doctoral program
 - Publications
 - Structure of the thesis (sections, cumulative dissertation, ...)
 - Meetings
- Working Place:
 - Office infrastructure
 - Mailing lists
- Employment:
 - Tasks
 - Teaching
 - Meetings and performance reviews

Thesis Agreement

Safety measure for yourself:

- Announcement of a doctoral thesis¹
- Thesis agreement²
- Application for approval of the courses for the doctoral program³
- Monitoring of your schedule
- Jour fixes with your supervisor

Cumulative Dissertation¹

Facts

- Dean of studies and supervisor need to agree
- Obligatory number of publications neccessary

Best Practices

- Supervisors dislike/like cumulative structure
- Heavily depends on research group
- Number and quality of publications hard to predict

Tuition Fees

- Students' union fee: 22.70 EUR¹
- Tuition fee: either 363.36 EUR or 726.72 EUR²
 - Citizens of EU/EEA and Switzerland, recognised refugees: 363.36 EUR after 8 semester
 - Citizens on Non-EU countries with exceptions
- Has to be paid in time for the continuation of your studies!
- Remission of the tuition fee
 - Long-winded illness
 - Employment at TU Wien with some restrictions
 - Pregnancy
- Extended admission period NOT for remission.

- Regular students in the doctoral program
- Employed by TU Wien for at least 20 hours per week
- After end of your employment (lasting at least for 6 semesters) in the semester of your defence
